

Flashback Antiques will be celebrating its Fifth Anniversary on Friday and





The newly added area also debuts The Maker's Room, which is dedicated to vintage pieces and parts that will bring remodeling, artistic endeavors and Pinterest projects to life. Makers and artists will find everything from rusty tin, old doors and windows, fixtures, hardware or old project pieces to interesting metal pieces that pickers bring in.

The creativity behind this funky and fun shop comes from owners Steve and Jonelle Kelly. These real life pickers celebrated the market's one-year anniversary in June and are enjoying making The Picker's Palace a success. "We traveled extensively this summer to find great stuff and brought it all back to our friends and followers here in the valley," Jonelle added.

## Calling on a banana?! **Novelty Advertising Telephones**

by Jay Mark

In many respects, technology is a marvelous thing. If we compare our lives to a generation ago, the contrast is stark. Technology has made us an unconsciously addictive society.

Our dependence on computers is irreversible. Even if you

don't use a desktop, laptop or tablet computer, you are interacting with one every day. Every time you get in your car you are communicating with a computer. Smart phones are really computers that can make calls. Cameras are just computers with optics.

Computers have infiltrated our lives. It takes a conscious effort and major sacrifice to deliberately go "off line."

One of the biggest changes in our lives is the telephone. A recent report by the federal government indicates that more than 51% of American homes



With the evolution of miniaturized components, telephone cases could be produced in an infinite variety of shapes. The iconic Heinz Ketchup bottle was one of the more innovative designs.

Telegraph), affectionately known as "Ma Bell." Western Electric was the manufacturing arm consistently producing the rock-solid, black phones we all grew up with. Clunky, but efficient, dependability trumped design. In fact, the frumpy Western Electric telephone may arguably be the most reliable appliance ever manufactured.


A sea change in phone ownership came in 1977 with the breakup of AT&T—giving rise to more telephone companies and a greater variety of new telephone styles. The dissolution of the monopoly gave rise to innovative and, yes, sometimes crass designs.


Technology and competition resulted in many miniaturized telephone components. That meant a working phone could be built into


any shaped case—thereby introducing the era of the novelty and advertising phone. Beginning in the 1960s, but reaching its peak in the 1980s, the plastic novelty telephone became a popular fixture in many homes and offices.

Back in 1986, Patricia Leigh Brown commented in the New York Times just how dramatically phones had evolved. "Where once simple black boxes sporting elegant dials ruled,

today Alexander Graham Bell's invention comes in a menagerie of forms that include Coca-Cola bottles, toucans, peek-a-boo Lucite globes and, in the case of the desk-top Versailles phone, a reproduction Renoir discreetly planted in the number card."

"...the brave new world of telephone design, where taste and tackiness collide" has made the corded phones of 1986 obsolete. That got me wondering how the change has impacted an area of collecting for which I have always had a passion—novelty telephones.

They offered businesses a new, innovative way to market themselves. In the early 1990s, for example, Sports Illustrated subscriptions were sagging. So their clever marketers came up the idea of offering a free football-shaped telephone with every subscription. Regrettably, the phone was too bulky for everyday use so it did not help raise subscription numbers. But that moved SI to come up with a new idea—the "sneaker" phone—a telephone in a real-looking, canvas sneaker.

Deregulation, the ability to mold plastic into unlimited shapes, and imagination opened the floodgates to a new, albeit short-lived, industry. During its relatively brief run, novelty phones gave a new look to an otherwise mundane, utilitarian



device. Some might argue there was even an artistic component to these innovative phones.

Now that a majority of American homes no longer have

landlines, the once wonderful and visually expressive novelty phones have become dinosaurs. Without a phone jack, they are mere paperweight decorations and no longer have practical uses. Is their future a consignment to the scrap heap? Or maybe a second life as a collectible.

Novelty phones fall into several categories: product advertising, character, figural and general novelty. I hope these expressive devices enjoy a reprieve and are given another chance.

If the desire is to build a collection, hundreds of styles are available and are reasonably affordable. Although some can reach \$200 or more, most novelty phones can be found starting at about \$10.



Mickey Mouse is arguably the most recognized figure on the planet and was a logical choice for Disney to incorporate into a novelty push-button telephone in 1976.

Here are some representative novelty phone values tabulated in August 2017:

Heinz Ketchup Bottle Phone, \$29.99; Sewing Machine Telephone, \$70; Sports Illustrated Sneaker phone, \$10-25; Sports Illustrated Football phone, \$35; Coca Cola Telephone, \$14.99:

Hint: As with most collectible items, condition is paramount. Cracked plastic, faded colors, frayed cords and missing parts all contribute to a significant diminution in value.

A good book: While many volumes have been written on the history of telephones, *Collectible Novelty Phones* by James David Davis, Schiffer Books (1998) is the only book exclusively dedicated to the subject. It illustrates more than 200 of the most "phonetastic" novelty phones from the 1970s to 1990s.
