## Authentic Cowboy and Western Shopping & Once-in-a-Lifetime Collection Auction at 29th Annual Old West Show & Auction in Mesa

The 2019 Western art and antiques season kicks-off with **Brian Lebel's 29th Annual Old West Show & Auction** on January 25, 26 and 27 in Mesa. Featured are over 180 show dealers as well as an exciting two-night live auction that includes the extensive Robert G. McCubbin collection—a once-in-a-life auction opportunity!

The **Show & Auction** (formerly the High Noon Show & Auction) will be at the Mesa Convention Center, 263 N. Center Street, and the adjacent Delta Hotels Phoenix Marriott Mesa, 200 Centennial Way.

The Saturday and Sunday **Old West Show** features national dealers offering authentic cowboy, western and Native American art, antiques and design, apparel, décor, jewelry, collectibles, antique firearms, Native American artifacts, photography, boots, books and much more in all price ranges. It will be held at the Mesa Convention Center from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Sunday. General admission is \$10/day with children under 12 admitted free. Discount tickets may be purchased online or bring the ad with you for a discount at the door. A special Friday "VIP early buy-in" is available for \$100.

This year's **Old West Auction** includes the most extensive and important collections of American Western photos and documents in private hands with over 1,500 individual pieces of photography, artifacts and ephemera in the Robert G. McCubbin Collection. Offered in its entirety for public auction, it features the most anticipated and highest estimated lot of both sales—the well-documented knife that outlaw Billy the Kid was holding when he was shot dead by Pat Garrett. It is valued from \$800,000 to \$1.2 million.

The photography portion of the McCubbin Collection will be sold exclusively at the special Friday night auction and the historic

artifacts and ephemera will be offered during Saturday night's auction. Both auctions will be held at the Phoenix Marriott Mesa and begin at 5 p.m.

Pre-sale estimates for the McCubbin Collection exceed \$4 million. Among the photographic highlights are rare and historic photos of notable Old West figures such as Calamity Jane, Wild Bill Hickok, Bat Masterson, Belle Star, Geronimo and many others. McCubbin purchased an original and highly desirable photograph of Butch Cassidy, Sundance, and the Wild Bunch directly from the Pinkerton National Detective Agency. A tintype of John Wesley Hardin from Hardin's personal photo album is among the rarities as is Doc Holliday's Dental School graduation photo, a carte de visite and a cabinet card of a 17 year-old Jesse James.

Auction owner Brian Lebel, who has known Robert McCubbin for almost 30 years, said, "I have always had a tremendous amount of respect for Bob and his collection. He has the passion of a collector but the discipline of a scholar." McCubbin collected much of his rare and valuable material directly from the descendants of the subjects or other verifiable sources and many of the most important pieces are accompanied by impeccable provenance.

The collection is being sold both as individual pieces and grouped into lots and may be previewed on-site on Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Catalogs are available for sale or viewable online. Bidding may be done live, online, by mobile, by phone or absentee. Bidder registration, auctions and previews are free and open to the public.

inexpensive, but wildly popular. Ever since they were introduced, animated Mickey Mouse watches have been worn less for time telling and more for the pure joy of having the world's most beloved rodent close at hand. That's why tens of millions have been sold.

In the beginning it was a sheer delight for children to watch their favorite cartoon character's stick-thin arms gyrating around a body clad in baggy red pants with oversized yellow gloves pointing roughly to the hours and minutes. Meanwhile, three mini-Mickeys chased each other in a circle at the bottom of the dial keeping track of seconds. For many youngsters, it was an introduction to reading a clock face.

A scrawny little mouse named Mickey first appeared on the silver screen in 1928 in two forgettable silent cartoons—Plane Crazy and The Gallopin' Gaucho. Later that year, Steamboat Willie debuted with a synchronized audio track. Sound gave a voice to Mickey who was then catapulted into an overnight success.

Merchandising followed soon after. Within a year of Mickey's debut, Disney was paid \$300 for the rights to put the



little mouse's likeness on a school tablet.

By 1933, under the supervision of Herman Samuel Kominetzky—popularly known as Herman “Kay” Kamen who had previously marketed Our Gang merchandise—the sales of Mickey products soared into the millions of dollars, an enormous sum during the Great Depression.

The task of transforming Kamen's idea for a child's wristwatch featuring Mickey Mouse fell in 1933 to August Shallack, an artist employed in the advertising department of United Artists, distributors of Disney films. Shallack created what would become the iconic artwork for an inexpensive paper-faced dial. Disney copyrighted the design in June of that year.

The Ingersoll-Waterbury Watch

Company of Waterbury, Connecticut, a firm on the verge of bankruptcy was awarded the exclusive rights to produce Mickey Mouse watches “in perpetuity.” Little did they know at the time that the agreement would save Ingersoll from being another casualty of the Depression.

Ingersoll began in 1880 when 21-year-old Robert and 15-year-old Charles Ingersoll contracted with the Waterbury Clock Company to manufacture 12,000 pocket watches of their design.

In 1883, the brothers designed a watch that could be sold for only \$1.00. Along with its general popularity, Ingersoll watches were ultimately worn by the rich and famous. By 1922, when the Waterbury Clock Company purchased Ingersoll, more than 50 million watches had been sold.

But the Depression took its toll on Ingersoll-Waterbury. The company was on the ropes when the Disney contract came along. The Mickey Mouse watch made its debut in 1933 at the



Chicago Exposition "Century of Progress," at the height of the Great Depression.

In its first two years, 2.5 million Mickey Mouse watches were sold earning Disney an enormous \$250,000 in royalties—about \$4.8 million today.

The first Mickey Mouse wristwatch sold for \$3.25. That's about \$63 in today's dollars—a steep price for a child's watch especially during the Depression. Later, the price was reduced to a more modest \$2.95. Meanwhile, a pocket watch was introduced at \$1.50.

Following the Exposition, the watches were marketed in major department stores like Marshall-Fields and Macy's. So great a sensation was the watch that it reappeared at the 1939 New York World's Fair.

The Mickey Mouse watch may be Disney's most successful piece of merchandising ever. In 1957, thirty-four years after its debut, 25 million had sold. Two years later, U.S. Time became Timex and continued turning out Mickey Mouse Watches.

Beginning in 1968, with the continuing popularity of Mickey Mouse timepieces, Disney increased the stable of manufactures



to include along with Timex, Elgin, Hamilton, Helbros and Vantage Watch companies. Still more companies were added later beginning with Lorus, a division of Seiko in 1986, and then Bulova, Colibri, Fossil, Disney Time Works, and Seiko.

Eighty-five years after his first appearance, the Mickey Mouse wristwatch continues to be a best seller.

Today, an early Mickey watch in running condition with its original strap and packaging can sell for more than \$100. Some rare styles have exceeded \$1000.00.

HINT: Inexpensively made, these watches need to be handled carefully and cleaned regularly. Never wind completely.

A GOOD BOOK; Robert Heide & John Gilman compiled a fascinating history in their 1997 book *The Mickey Mouse Watch, From the Beginning of Time*.


