### 15th Home Tour & Antique Show In Superior, January 28-29, 2023

The **15th Annual Superior Home Tour & Antique Show** will take place on January 28th and 29th in the historic mining town of Superior. Hosted by the **Superior Chamber of Commerce**, the event offers ticket holders a chance to explore several unique homes in the historic community.

This year's tour includes "The Surprise House," a brick home built in the 1920s that has been fully restored. The home has retained much of its original character including the kitchen that features the original cabinets from a bygone era. The home is one of several in the area that housed the mine supervisors from Magma Copper Mine and were company owned until the 1970s.

The **Antique Show** will take place at the Magma Club, a beautifully restored 100+ year old building in downtown Superior. The building once hosted dinners, dancing and boxing matches for Magma Mine workers. Attendees can browse quality antiques or relax and listen to live music on the veranda while taking in the mountain views.

Both days begin with a pancake breakfast. Throughout the day, attendees can explore at their own pace while also taking part in guided hikes or listening to dynamic speakers. Attendees will hear stories of Superior's history and the legends who once roamed there—including Mattie Blaylock, Wyatt Earp's common-law wife, who is buried in the Pinal Cemetery just outside of town. This year's speakers include Wyatt Earp, a descendant of the western lawman. In addition, the **Tour** will feature handmade pottery for sale from the Mexican village of Mata Ortiz and a chance to browse the various shops in downtown Superior.



Clock and watch collectors and repair experts will display, sell and trade modern and antique watches and clocks as well as tools, parts and literature at the annual **Arizona Sunshine Regional Watch and Clock Show** on Friday and Saturday, March 10th and 11th.

This unique event will be held at the Fountain Hills Community Center, 13001 N. La Montana Dr. in Fountain Hills. It is hosted by the National Association of Watch and Clock Collectors (NAWCC) Arizona Sunshine Chapter 112, assisted by Keywinders of Arizona Chapter 46 and Southern Arizona Chapter 113.

On Friday, the show is open to NAWCC members only and is closed to the public. Not a member? Apply for a special 1st Time Membership for only \$52 for the first year! You can add \$14 for USA mailed publications. Join at NAWCC.ORG or at the AZ Sunshine Regional Registration Desk.

On Saturday, the show is open to the public from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Admission is \$5.00 and free to children under 18 years of age. Parking is free.

Saturday's events feature a "Clock and Watch Roadshow" when the public is invited to bring their watch and clock treasures and verbal evaluations of timepieces will be available at no cost. This has proven to be a very popular event with lines of people waiting to have their items assessed.

Horological videos will be playing and you can take a break and learn at the same time. Free coffee and refreshments are available on both days. Educational classes and seminars will be held.

2023 Sunshine Regional Exhibit Items

The exhibit at the Arizona Sunshine Regional Watch and Clock Show is entirely composed of items from its member's personal collections. Here is some information about Novelty and Steampunk Clocks and Watches at the Show that are sure to be entertaining and of interest.

What is a Novelty Timepiece? Novelty clocks and watches combine the functionality of a familiar ob-ject and give it a new twist that may make you smile or at least appreciate the originality of their unique designs. Many are relatively inexpensive to buy, and they often have cheaply made mechanisms that make them poor timekeepers—some incorporate animated and musical features that appeal to custom-ers' interests or sense of humor. Antique gold-plated pot metal clocks often mimicked more expensive bronze-cased French clocks of the time. Character watches and clocks have images of movie stars or cartoon figures like Mickey Mouse on their dials. Some clocks are overly complicated Rube Goldberg contraptions. Many are intriguing in their design and are fun to look at, which may outweigh their poor timekeeping ability. The category is very popular, which can be verified by a simple search on the Internet or Amazon.com.

What is a Steampunk Timepiece? Steampunk may be defined as "where history and fantasy collide with technology." Science fiction writer K. W. Jeter coined the term Steampunk in 1987 to describe his novel Morlock Night and the fantasy novels inspired by the writings of H. G. Wells and Jules Verne. Jeter's stories were set in Victorian times and celebrated the technology of the day, which was often powered by steam. Steampunk clocks and watches incorporate timekeeping mechanisms into industri-al-looking fantasy-inspired case designs that may include non-functioning machine parts such as valves, dials, gauges, and levers. The steampunk genre remains popular and continues to influence fashion styles, movie themes, and video games.

After judging, all of the trays that were entered into competition are placed on racks for public viewing during the Show. The winners receive prize money and are awarded ribbons.

Button collecting first became an organized hobby in Chicago in 1938. The National Button Society was then formed and their first show was the following year in Chicago. Button collecting didn't come to the young state of Arizona until the 1970s and there has been an annual show in Arizona since 1973. This year the local clubs are celebrating their 50th Anniversary Show! ASBS is happy to have some original club members who will be attending the show as well as family members who have become members and also love collecting antique and vintage buttons aka Tiny Treasures!

Arizona has four active button collecting group clubs that meet monthly and are located in the West Valley, East Valley, Tucson and Prescott—all of which are associated with the ASBS. Membership dues are \$20 per year (\$2 for children) and include an emailed Bulletin three times a year with articles, photos, project topics, historical button research and more.







and I really enjoyed watching the process and having fun with the other people who were attending. There are plans to add monthly Saturday auctions and I'm looking forward to checking out another auction soon.

Ray explained why Desert Mercantile is unique, saying, "We are a non-traditional antique mall with additional services, such as a full live auction, a hardware store within the mall, U-Haul rentals and a FedEx shipping center. We want our customers to enjoy fun and welcoming buying experiences."

He continued, "The area we chose for the Mall has been an ideal place to have our business and be partners with a welcoming community. We have had a tremendous experience getting to know our customers and our goal is to provide great service to our customers and our community."
